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Fruits are produced round the year in Bangladesh. Nevertheless, the weather and the topography are more suitable for summer fruit production. Generally 9 major and 48 minor fruits are produced in this country. Area devoted to these fruits accounts for 1,39,535 hectares. Major fruits, such as mango, banana, jackfruit, pineapple, papaya, litchi and jujube are produced on 79 percent of the area. Minor fruits are produced on rest 21 percent of the fruit area.

Fruits from Bangladesh are now exported to about 60 countries around the world



At present, there are 630 fruit processing industries in Bangladesh. Out of them, 30 industries prepare jam, jelly, fruit juice, ketchup, sauce, canned pineapple, sliced and canned mango pulp and other processed products. Some of these products are exported abroad. This type of industries should be extended further. Moreover, appropriate transportation and cold storage system should be developed for internal marketing of fruits. Besides, special care should be taken while peaking fruits from the trees.
